### **POSI PRESIDENT**

India is a vast country, the health care of which is a challenge. As the initial euphoria of technical surgery ebbs, a surgeon realizes that there are so many patients who present late with complex orthopaedic problems which could have been prevented. With further maturity, the futility of preventable surgery and the truth and power of the adage 'Prevention is better than cure' comes home!

At this meeting we hope to go deep into these areas, familiarize the participants with the Indian programs and give great thought to implementation of the surveillance guidelines. The eminent international faculty will give us the benefit of their experience and expertise. I take great pleasure to invite you to this meeting and am hoping that it will prove a game changer for our children.
